No function is complete without gifts and most gifts cost money, Lets estimate this cost

What is a function without entertainment, Let's have some fun included in our function with music, hosts, photographers, videographers etc. to capture those memories.

### Step 6

Finally, each wedding has a theme and requires specific decorations, fancy props or floral decorations. Lets estimate all of them in below table:

Miscellaneous	Cost of each
Total	G
